




Admission Policy

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The seats available for a given program is divided into two categories viz., category ‘A’ seats and category ‘B’ seats.

Category ‘A’ Policy Statements:

Admission to category ‘A’ seats (70% of the sanctioned intake) is made by the Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE).

Admission to category ‘B’ seats (30% of the sanctioned intake) which fall under the Management quota is made by the college as per the guidelines issued by TSCHE. For ‘A’ category seats, TSCHE issues the notification in the news papers and invites applications for admission to various colleges affiliated to JNTUH. The list of colleges with the number of seats available for B.Tech/ M.Tech and MBA programs in each college is uploaded on its website.

The notification for admission to ‘B’ category inviting applications for admission is issued by the college in the form advertisement in the news papers Web portal is also created by the college and online applications are facilitated. The college management follows the procedure laid down by the TSCHE for the admission process. After completing the admission process, the college submits the list of admitted candidates to TSCHE, which scrutinizes the list and approves it, after ensuring that the prescribed procedure had been followed by the college.

ADMISSION TO CATEGORY ‘A’ SEATS

1. Eligibility for admissions to 1st year B. E /B. Tech programs

I. The candidate should have passed the Intermediate Exam (10 +2) with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects or any other examination of any other University or Authority accepted by the Director of Technical Education, as equivalent.

II. The candidate should have qualified in the common entrance test conducted by the Telangana State Government — EAMCET. Ranks are allocated based on the performance in the test

III. The candidate should belong to the state of Telangana / Andhra Pradesh. The candidates should satisfy local / non – local status requirements as laid down in the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 as subsequently amended.

2. Eligibility for admissions to 2nd year BE/B.Tech programs under Lateral Entry scheme

I. The candidate should have passed the Diploma in Engineering/Technology, awarded by the State Board of Technical Education, Telangana, or its equivalent

II. The candidate should have qualified in the Engineering Common Entrance Test (ECET) conducted by the Telangana State Government. Ranks are allocated based on the performance in the test.

III. The candidate should belong to the state of Telangana / Andhra Pradesh. The candidates should satisfy local / non – local status requirements as laid down in the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 as subsequently amended.

3. Eligibility for admission to M.Tech programs

I. Education Qualification / Eligibility criteria.

- a. The candidate should have passed the appropriate qualifying examination i.e., B.Tech/A.I.M.E./B.Planning/M.Sc./M.C.A or equivalent examination.
- b. The candidate should secure the following percentage of marks in the Qualifying examination. 50% - For all candidates 45% - The candidates belonging to reserved categories:

II. The candidate should have secured a rank at common Entrance test, PGECET conducted by the Telangana State Government or secured a GATE score.

4. Eligibility for admission to MBA program

I. The candidates should have passed the qualifying examination i.e., any degree from a recognized university in India in 10+2+3 pattern.

II. The Candidate should have qualified in the common entrance test (ICET) conducted by Telangana State Government

III. The candidate should satisfy local/non-local status requirements of admission into category 'A' seats as laid down in the relevant G.O. of AP/TS Government

METHOD OF ADMISSIONS

The college admits the candidates allotted by the convener of EAMCET/ECET/PGECET/ICET/ (Admissions.) The allotments are made based on the online/e- options exercised by the candidates, the rank obtained in the entrance tests and reservation category to which the candidates belong. The online or e-option mechanism ensures transparency in the admission process.

ADMISSION TO CATEGORY 'B' SEATS

1. Eligibility and rules for admission to BE/B.Tech programs

I. The seats are filled on merit basis with candidates including from other States and union territories, who have secured rank at AIEEE (JEE-Main) and secured not less than 45% (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) of marks in the prescribed group subjects in the qualifying examination.

II. The seats remaining unfilled from the above are filled with eligible candidates on merit basis following eligibility criteria laid down in rule (4) of G.O.Ms.No.74 as follows: The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination (10+2) conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana or equivalent with Physics, Mathematics and chemistry as compulsory subjects and obtained at-least 45% marks in the above subjects taken together/ (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) and should have secured a rank at the common entrance test, conducted by the Telangana State Government - EAMCET

III. Thereafter, if any seats still remain unfilled, such seats may be filled on merit basis with candidates securing not less than 45% (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) in the prescribed group subjects taken together/aggregate marks in the qualifying examination (IPE of Telangana or equivalent)

2. Eligibility for admission to M.Tech Program

I. Education Qualification / Eligibility criteria.

a. The candidate should have passed the appropriate qualifying examination i.e., B.Tech/A.I.M.E./B.Planning/M.Sc./M.C.A or equivalent examination.

b. The candidate should secure the following percentage of marks in the Qualifying examination. 50% - For all candidates 45% - The candidates belonging to reserved categories:

II. The candidate should have secured a rank at common Entrance test, PGECET conducted by the Telangana State Government or secured a GATE score.

3. Eligibility for admission to MBA Program

I. Education Qualification:

a. The candidates should have passed the qualifying examination i.e., any degree from recognized university in India in 10+2+3 on the date of his/her admission into MBA programme.

b. The candidate should have secured the following percentage of marks in the qualifying examination. 50% - For all candidates, 45% - The candidates belonging to reserved categories.

II. The candidate should have secured a rank at common Entrance test, ICET conducted by the Telangana State Government or All India Common Entrance Test.

ADMISSION PROCESS

1. The following procedure as prescribed by TSCHE is followed for admission of candidates.

1. The college notifies the details of the courses offered with intake, schedule of admission in popular news dailies one each language ie., English, Telugu and Urdu. A copy of this advertisement is displayed on the college notice board and also on the college website.
2. Applications forms for admissions are made available in the college or can be downloaded from the website
3. The applications received are scrutinized and a merit list of eligible candidates is prepared and uploaded on the web portal of the college.
4. While preparing the merit list, the order of preference to be followed as per the TSCHE guidelines is taken into consideration.
5. The list of admitted candidates is forwarded to TSCHE for approval.
6. The competent authority in TSCHE verifies the list and if found in accordance with the rules and procedures prescribed by TSCHE, approves the same.

Rules of Reservation for Admissions

Reservation for local Candidates

Admission to 85% of the seats in each Course shall be reserved for the local candidates and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved as specified in the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended (Details enclosed in Annexure-I).

Reservation for SC/ST/BC Communities

- (i) There shall be reservation of seats for SCs, STs and BCs as specified here under.
 - (A) Scheduled Castes A total of 15% of seats in each Course shall be reserved for Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes Category.
 - (B) Scheduled Tribes A total of 6% of seats in each Course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes Category.
 - (C) Backward Classes A total of 29% seats in each Course shall be reserved for the candidates in respect of Backward classes candidates as shown below:
 - Group - A 7%
 - Group - B 10%
 - Group - C 1%
 - Group - D 7%
 - Group - E 4%

- (ii) Candidates belonging to the above categories should submit Community, Nativity and Date of Birth Certificate as per G.O.Ms.No.58 of Social Welfare Department, dt.12.05.1997.

(iii) SC, ST and BC candidates who get seats on merit will not be considered against the seat reserved for them and such candidates will be considered under the general category of seats.

(iv) If sufficient number of candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for SCs they shall be filled up by suitable candidates from STs and vice-versa. If the required number of candidates is not available for filling up the quota of seats reserved for SCs and STs they may be filled up by candidates from the general pool on the basis of the merit.

(v) While filling up the seats reserved for Backward Class -A, the qualified Backward Class-A candidates should be considered in the order of merit. If qualified Backward Class-A candidates are not available, the turn will go to Backward Class-B, Backward Class-C, Backward Class-D or Backward Class-E in the order of merit in each group. If no suitable candidates are available in any of the five groups, the seats shall be filled up from general pool on the basis of merit.

Reservation of Seats for NCC and Games & Sports/ Extra Curricular Activities/ Children of Ex-Servicemen and Armed Personnel:

A Maximum of 4.5% of the seats of Degree Courses shall be reserved for the candidates who have distinguished themselves in Sports, Extra-Curricular activities, N.C.C and children of Ex-Servicemen and Armed Personnel as follows:-

(i) Reservation for N.C.C : 1% of the seats are reserved for the students possessing the prescribed certificates in N.C.C. The selection of the candidates shall be made according to the G.O.Ms.No.14, Higher Education (TE) Department, dt.09.06.2017.

If suitable candidate is not available for any seat in the above categories, the same shall be filled up from general pool on the basis of merit.

(ii) Reservation of seats for Games and Sports: 2 % of the seats are reserved for students who have participated in the following games and sports (list given below). The selection of the candidates under this category shall be made according to the G.O.Ms.No.20, Youth Advancement, Tourism & Culture (Sports) Department, dated: 24.08.2009.

Badminton If suitable candidate is not available for any seat in the above categories, the same shall be filled up from general pool on the basis of merit.

(iii) Reservation of seats for Extra-Curricular activities:

(a) 1% of the total seats shall be reserved for students who participated in Extra Curricular activities such as Elocution, Debates, Essay and Fine Arts like Dance, Drama, Music, Painting, Photography and President Scouts and Guides Certificate holders. The selection of candidates shall be made in the following order of preference:-

(A) Candidates who have represented India at the International level in Extra Curricular activities and President Scouts and Guides.

(B) Candidates who have represented the State at the All India level in the Extra Curricular activities or obtained prize at the competition of All India level.

(C) Candidates who have represented the College at the Inter Collegiate level and those who have participated at Inter School level.

(b) Whenever there are more number of candidates with a similar merit than the actual number of seats available under the categories specified in item (A), (B), and (C) above, admission shall be regulated by the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

(c) If suitable candidate is not available for any seat in the above categories in the same shall be filled up from general pool on the basis of merit.

(iv) Reservation of seats for Children of Ex-Servicemen and Children of Armed Personnel (CAP):

2% of the seats are reserved for children of Ex-Servicemen and Children of Armed personnel according to G.O.Ms.No.19 & 20, Higher Education (TE/A2) Department, dated:08.07.2015 and shall be in the following order of preference:-

(a) Children of Armed Forces Personnel killed in action.

(b) Children of Armed Personnel disabled in action and invalidated out from service on Medical grounds.

(c) Children of Armed Forces Personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards, the order of merit for consideration of the Gallantry Awards being as given below:

- i. Parm Vir Chakra vi. Uttam Youdh Seva Medal
- ii. Asoka Chakra vii. Vir Chakra
- iii. Sarvotham Yodh Seva Medal viii. Shourya Chakra
- iv. Mahavir Chakra x. Yudha Seva Medal
- v. Kirti Chakra x. Seva/Nau Sena/Vayu Sena Medal
- xi Mention of Dispatches

(d) Children of other Ex-Servicemen.

(v) If suitable candidate is not available for any seat in the above categories, the same shall be filled up from general pool on the basis of merit.

Reservation of Seats for Physically Challenged:

(a) According to the G.O.Ms.No.339, Education (EC.2) Department, dated:15.12.1999, (Visually Challenged/Impaired, Hearing Impaired, Orthopedically Challenged) 3% of the total number of seats in the 1st year of Degree Courses shall be reserved for the Physically Challenged persons in the following order:-

There shall be horizontal reservation in each category (OC, BC, SC and ST) in each Course of an institution, for the following categories, to the extent indicated against them:-

- i. Visually Challenged/Impaired - 1%

- ii. Hearing Impaired - 1%
- iii. Orthopedically Challenged - 1%

(b) The classifications with regard to the above priorities shall be as follows:-

(i) Visually Challenged/Impaired: A person can be said to be Visually Challenged if the vision is from 6/18 up to 6/60 and anything less than 6/60 shall be considered as an extreme handicap. The above criteria shall also be made applicable to persons with vision in both the eyes, but coming within the range of defects indicated above.

(ii) Orthopedically Challenged:

Defects of upper limbs:

(a) Quadriplegic (loss of use of 4 limbs shall be considered as the top-most priority in this category).

(b) Loss of both the limbs – preference shall be given to loss of upper limbs from the above downwards.

Defect of lower limbs:

The criteria applicable to upper limbs shall also be applied to lower limbs with preference to be given for the loss of limbs from the above downwards.

(iii) Hearing Impaired: The Deaf are those in whom the sense of hearing is non-functional for ordinary purpose of life. They do not hear and understand at all even with amplified speech. The cases included in this category will be those having less / more than 90 decibels in the better ear (profound impairment) or total loss of hearing in both cases. A person is deaf if he cannot hear for all practical purposes being deaf in both the ears. Persons using hearing aids are to be considered as deaf.

(c) The loss of one eye or one upper limb or one lower limb shall be given a very low priority.

(d) In case suitable candidates are not available for any seat such seat shall be filled from general pool on the basis of merit.

Reservation of Seats for Women Candidates:

(i) Wherever applicable, a minimum of 33 1/3% of the available seats in each Course will be allotted to women candidates from each category, i.e., OC/SC/ST/BC/PH/CAP/Sports/Extra Curricular Activities.

(ii) This rule is not applicable if women candidates selected on merit in each category exceed 33.33% or more of the seats therein.

(iii) In the absence of suitable women candidates in the respective categories, these shall be filled with men candidates of the same category as per G.O.Ms.No.74, Higher Education (EC.2) Department, dated: 28.07.2011.

The Managements of **Non Minority/Minority** Private Unaided Engineering and Pharmacy colleges having AICTE recognition & University affiliation in Telangana State are required to follow the admission guidelines and admission schedule issued as below for conducting the **process of admissions to fill up 30% of seats under management quota (Category 'B')** into B.E/B.Tech, B.Pharmacy and Pharm-D courses for the academic year 2021-22 in a fair, transparent and non-exploitative manner.

a) **Guidelines for conducting Admissions for the academic year 2021-22:**

1. The Managements shall adhere to the time schedule announced by TSCHE given below for category 'B' admissions for the year 2021-22.
2. Notification shall be issued by the Managements of colleges in at least three leading news dailies, one in each language i.e., English, Telugu & Urdu and it should contain the following details:-
 - a) Minority/Non-Minority Status of the college
 - b) Management seats (30%) available, branch wise
 - c) Application format
 - d) Registration Fee to be paid and mode of payment
 - e) Tuition fee
 - f) Last date for submission of application by the candidates
 - g) Mode of submission (Online / In-person)
 - h) Venue for collecting blank application and submission of application form
3. Applying 'Online' by the candidates seeking admission shall be permitted. **The details of college web portal shall be provided.**
 - a) Managements shall entertain all the requisitions made before the last date for supply of application forms in person and shall issue acknowledgement to the applicants registered both online and offline.
 - b) Candidate shall submit duly filled in application form before the last date prescribed for submission to the Managements of the college concerned along with the prescribed registration fee in favour of the Management through Demand Draft / Payment gateway as indicated in the notification.
 - c) Those students who are desirous of applying to other colleges shall do so by submitting separate applications along with registration fees prescribed by them.
 - d) The filled in application form shall indicate the order of preference of the candidate for different courses offered by the college.

4. Managements shall maintain day wise register for recording the Receipt of Application Forms (candidate name, address, mobile number etc.,) in person.
5. Management shall issue necessary instructions to the candidates with regard to payment of Application & Registration Fee.
6. Eligibility Criteria and order of merit:
 - a) *NRI - The institutions that are approved by All India Council for Technical Education and permitted to fill NRI seats not exceeding 15% of the sanctioned intake in each course for the academic year shall admit NRI candidates (sons and daughters of NRIs) who have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% marks in the prescribed group subjects or 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a scale of 10.*
 - b) *JEE (Mains) - The remaining seats shall be filled on merit basis with candidates including from other States and Union territories who have given All India rank at JEE (Mains) and **passed in the qualifying examination conducted by TSBIE and TOSS (as per GO.Rt.No.129, Dt:18.08.2021).***
 - c) *TSEAMCET - The seats remaining unfilled from the above shall be filled with eligible candidates, who have qualified the TSEAMCET examination on merit basis following eligibility criteria laid in rule (4) of G.O's.74 & 75, Dated 28.07.2011.*
 - d) *Thereafter, if any seats still remain unfilled, such seats may be filled on merit basis with candidates passed in the qualifying examination, as prescribed.*
7. Managements shall prepare combined list of all the applicants, both applications received online and in-person for each course and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
8. Separate merit list of applicants shall also be prepared for each course on the basis of NRI Status / JEE (Mains) / TSEAMCET Rank / percentage of marks in the prescribed group subjects taken together/aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
9. Selection list of candidates for admission against the available seats for each course under Category 'B' admissions, shall be prepared discipline wise following the priorities of category of students (NRI, JEE Mains, TSEAMCET / Marks in the qualifying examination as prescribed in relevant G.O's. and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college
10. The Managements of Engineering Colleges are requested to issue **Admission Notification and close the admissions before: 15thOctober, 2021.**
Cutoff date for submission of Admission lists for approval of the Competent Authority, TSCHE **Will be issued later**

11. The date of reporting for admission to the college is informed to the selected candidates following the schedule announced by the authorities and acknowledgement of the candidate who joined at the college shall be obtained.
12. Vacant seats, if any, from the selection list shall be filled (branch wise) from the merit list of the applicants, which was announced already.
13. Class work of colleges for the academic year 2021-22 shall commence from the date as informed by the Authority.
14. The final admission list of the candidates shall be submitted to the Secretary, TSCHE on or before the cut-off date prescribed along with the copies of the following documents.
 - i) TSEAMCET – 2021 Rank Card / JEE Rank Card with Hall Ticket
 - ii) SSC / 10th Class Marks Memo
 - iii) Intermediate / Diploma Marks Memo
 - iv) Intermediate / Diploma Transfer Certificate
 - v) Community certificate (in case of SC/ST/BC)
 - vi) Recognition of Board and Equivalency certificate from BIE (in case of students who passed the qualifying examination from the states outside TS.)
 - vii) Equivalency from Board of Intermediate Education/Association of Indian Universities in respect of degrees acquired from countries outside India.
 - viii) List of Rejected candidates after conducting interviews with reasons
